Housing for older people

Our retirement schemes across London and southern England promote independence and provide the perfect home for older people to continue to live a full and rewarding life.

We offer self-contained homes that are specifically designed to meet the needs of older people, with different levels of care available.

We tailor our services to meet our customers' needs. We can provide additional privately-funded care on a short, medium and long-term basis. We also offer a variety of tenancies including leasehold and rental.

ACTIVITIES


Our diverse activity programmes help foster community spirit in our schemes and aim to tackle issues arising from social isolation. From arts, crafts and cooking, to wellbeing activities and computer and internet support, we offer a wide range of choices.

Our activity centres are open to anyone aged 55+, or over 50 with a disability, even if they are not an A2Dominion resident. We have highly skilled staff on-site to assist people with low and medium cognitive issues, including dementia.

CATERING

The nutrition and wellbeing of our residents is our priority, which is why we offer a restaurant service at our extra care schemes.

Our bespoke catering service offers quality chef-cooked meals for our residents, their families and the wider community. We can provide a delivered dinner service for residents to enjoy in the comfort of their own home.



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Our care services

We offer care services across many of our older persons' accommodation schemes. We support residents to remain independent where possible and have developed specialised services to cater to their needs.

Our care services include:

- personal care
- respite and specialist care
- help with medication
- shopping and preparing meals
- social activities and companionship
- cleaning, laundry and domestic services
- supporting and assisting with finances.



Setting Standards for Retirement Communities

As members of the Associated Retirement Community Operators (ARCO), we operate our schemes according to the principles laid down in the ARCO Consumer Code.

The code sets high standards for retirement community operators and provides a benchmark for good practice.



Our care services are regularly monitored by the Care Quality Commission (CQC). The CQC is an independent regulator and ensures our ability to provide high-quality adult social care services.

Homelessness

We provide support and high-quality accommodation for people who have become homeless or are at risk of becoming homeless.

Through our person-centred service, we create an environment that considers our residents' thinking, emotions, past experiences and personalities.

This approach allows them to build resilience and confidence, and helps them to maintain meaningful, independent lives after they leave our programme.

Our residents partner with a dedicated support worker to develop a specialised independent living plan, which may include support for:

- mental and physical health
- substance abuse
- education
- budgeting
- voluntary work.

We also run weekly drop-in sessions to help members of the community tackle issues which may result in them becoming homeless, including specialist substance abuse services.

HOUSING FIRST

The Housing First programme aims to help homeless people with multiple and complex needs, or histories of homelessness to stay in their own home.

We provide intensive peronalised support and case management to help people live, and continue to live, in a stable, independent home.

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Domestic abuse services

A2Dominion Domestic Abuse Services (ADAS) provides free emotional and practical support for anyone affected by any type of domestic abuse.

We provide access to a free domestic abuse helpline, covering Oxfordshire and West Berkshire, which is a confidential service for people to get advice and support from our experienced team of counsellors.

ADAS also provides the following specialist services:

- Refuges and places of safety
- The Anchor Programme working with people with complex needs in a group setting
- Counselling
- Support groups
- Community outreach services
- Volunteering and apprenticeship opportunities
- Training in supporting those experiencing domestic abuse
- Multi-agency work designing and delivering domestic abuse services.



Supporting young people and families

We provide support and quality accommodation for young, vulnerable people and help them prepare for and work through challenges in their life.

We also work with families to develop flexible, personalised support plans which help build resilience, purpose and the skills to succeed.

Our young parents programmes provide single parents and couples with the resources and confidence to thrive in their communities.
